

Public Notice – Fire Ban in Effect

As of May 12, 2021 at 8.00 a.m.

The Municipality of Alexander has implemented a fire ban effective May 12, 2021 at 8.00 a.m. as per By-Law No. 05-10, Section 7.1(C).IV until further notice. Fire risk is extremely high and such a ban will help to prevent wildfires from occurring. The following restrictions apply:

- NO OUTDOOR FIRES <u>INCLUDING</u> IN APPROVED FIRE <u>PITS</u>
- DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS IS NOT ALLOWED
- SKY LANTERNS ARE NOT PERMITTED

Offense and Penalties

It is an offense to contravene any provisions of this By-Law. Any conviction of an offence is subject to a penalty of not less than \$500.00

This order is made by resolution of Council for the Municipality of Alexander and will remain in effect until further notice.
