The Municipality of Alexander Gravel Crushing - 2021

1.0 Specifications

70,000 tonnes of gravel to be crushed as: **1" Traffic Gravel**

See the attached Appendix A for aggregate requirements.

All material shall:

- be stockpiled on site.
- meet the standard specifications of the Municipality of Alexander

The Municipality will ensure that material shall:

- be tested by an independent Lab.
- be scaled (measured) by an independent company, before, during and after crushing.

The Municipality shall provide:

- a porta pottie
- water

2.0 Location

Crushing will take place in the Municipality of Alexander Gravel Pit, located in SW 2-17-7 EPM, near Gull Lake, Manitoba.

- **Call to arrange a site visit.**

3.0 Time Line

70,000 tonnes of 1" traffic gravel must be crushed no later than October 30, 2021.
Start date and completion date to be decided upon award of the contract.

Lowest or any proposal may not necessarily be accepted.

6.0 Rights

- 6.1 The Municipality retains the right to reject any or all proposals.
- 6.2 The Municipality reserves the right to accept the proposal which it deems to be in the best interest of the Municipality.
- 6.3 Start date and completion date are to be decided upon award of the contract. Time is of the essence of this Agreement and in the event that the work is not completed in the time specified, the Contractor shall become liable for any additional costs incurred as damages to the Municipality. The amount of such damages may be deducted from any monies due to the Contractor.
- 6.4 In the event that the Contractor fails to complete this contract, the Contractor shall pay to the Municipality as liquidated damages \$1,000.00 per working day for each and every working day following such date during which such failure continues. The amount specified for liquidated damages as aforesaid is based upon a genuine pre-estimate of the Municipality's losses in the event the Contractor does not achieve the total performance by the date fixed herein.
- 6.5 The Contractor's performance of this contract shall be monitored and directed by the Municipality. The Contractor shall be required to maintain and submit records to the Municipality in the manner prescribed by the Municipality from time to time.
- 6.6 Submission of a proposal by interested parties acknowledges and accepts these terms.

7.0 Proposal to be submitted on the attached "Proposal Form" and include:

Written confirmation providing evidence of

- Liability Insurance coverage and
- Workers Compensation coverage.

The Contractor is responsible for all liability insurance coverage and Workers Compensation coverage including the costs.
